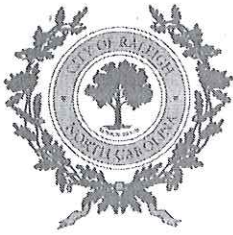



Description of Work - recommended ext. paint colors

We are requesting at COA to re-paint the Emmaus House back to a more historic and neighborhood-matching color scheme. Below are the details.

Sherwin Williams:

trim - **SW 7565 Oyster Bar** - this includes all columns, railings, window frames, door frames

ext. doors & window accent - **SW7630 Raisin** - works surprisingly well with the brick which has purple undertones - makes the house feel more a part of Oakwood

porch floor - **SW7651 Front Porch** - for painting porch floors, Sherwin Williams has a paint product specifically for porch floors

porch ceiling - **SW2827 Colonial Revival Stone** – the 'porch-ceiling-blue' look is too Charleston and does not feel like Oakwood, so we are avoiding that

Sheen will be HIGH GLOSS.
