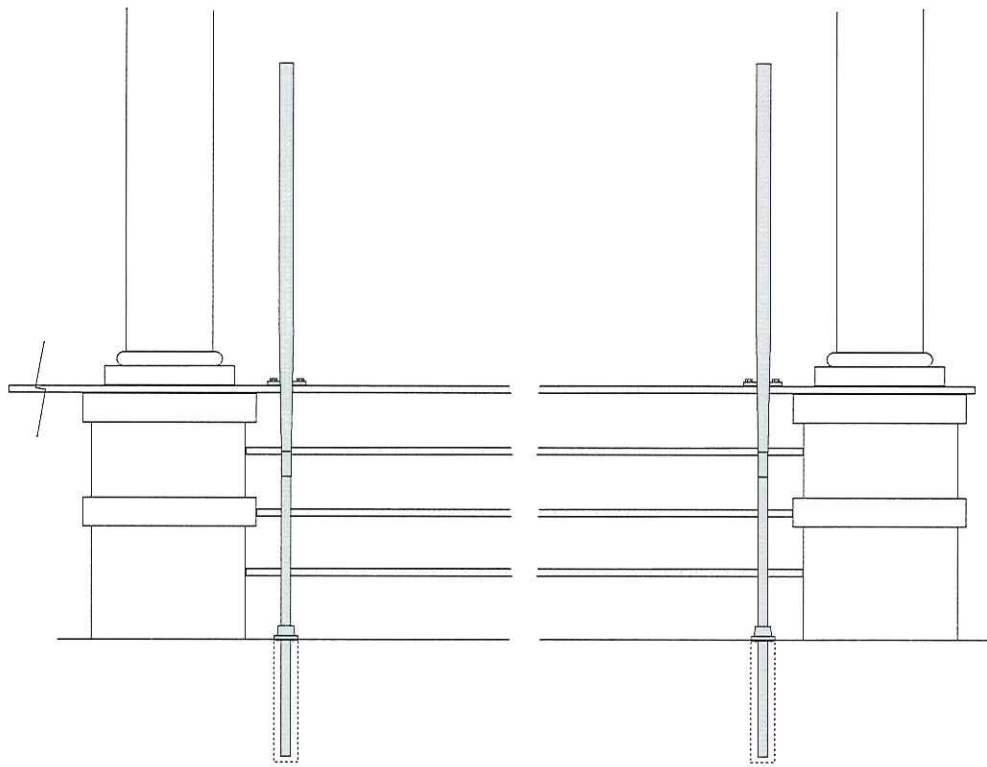

**Installation of set of two forged steel handrailings:**

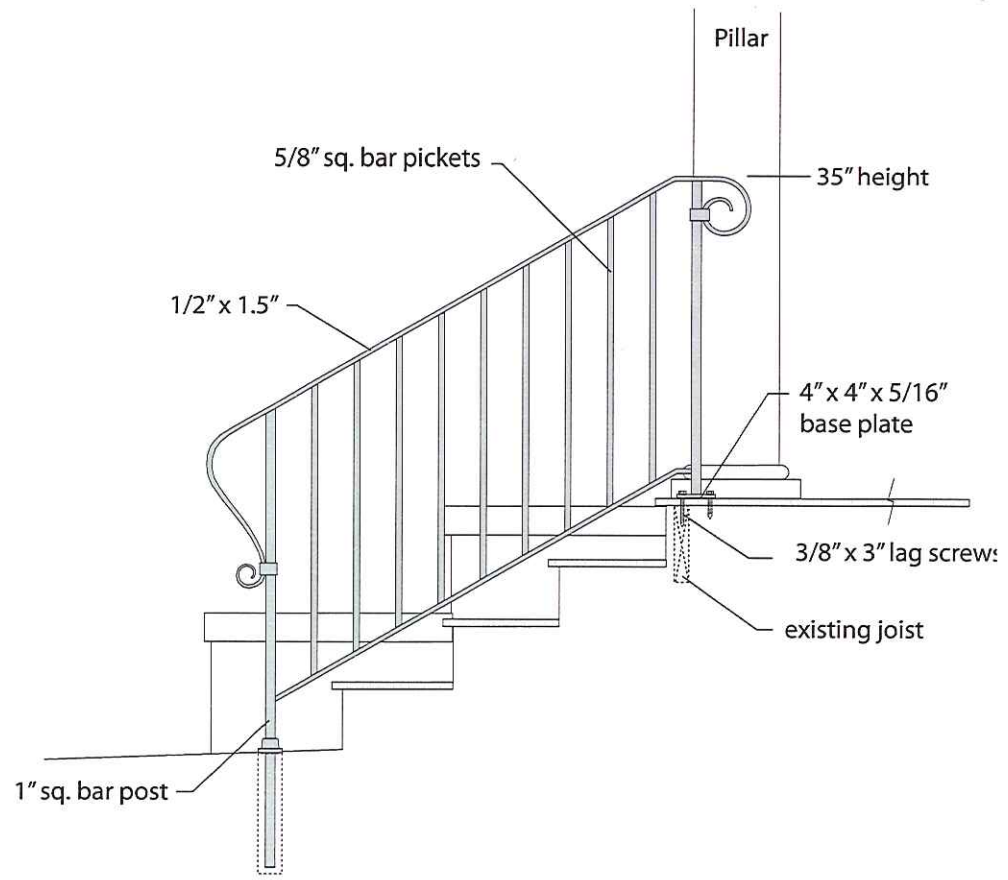
Railing are to be mounted using a 4" square base plate at the porch landing using 3/8" x 3" lag screws (see design drawing), and on the brick walkway below the first stair tread. The mounting into the walkway will be core-drilling a 2.5" dia. x 14" deep hole through the brick pavers and into the ground below. The posts will be set using anchoring cement.

All components of the railings are solid steel. The railings will be sandblasted prior to a rust-inhibitive acrylic paint to ensure the longevity of the finish.

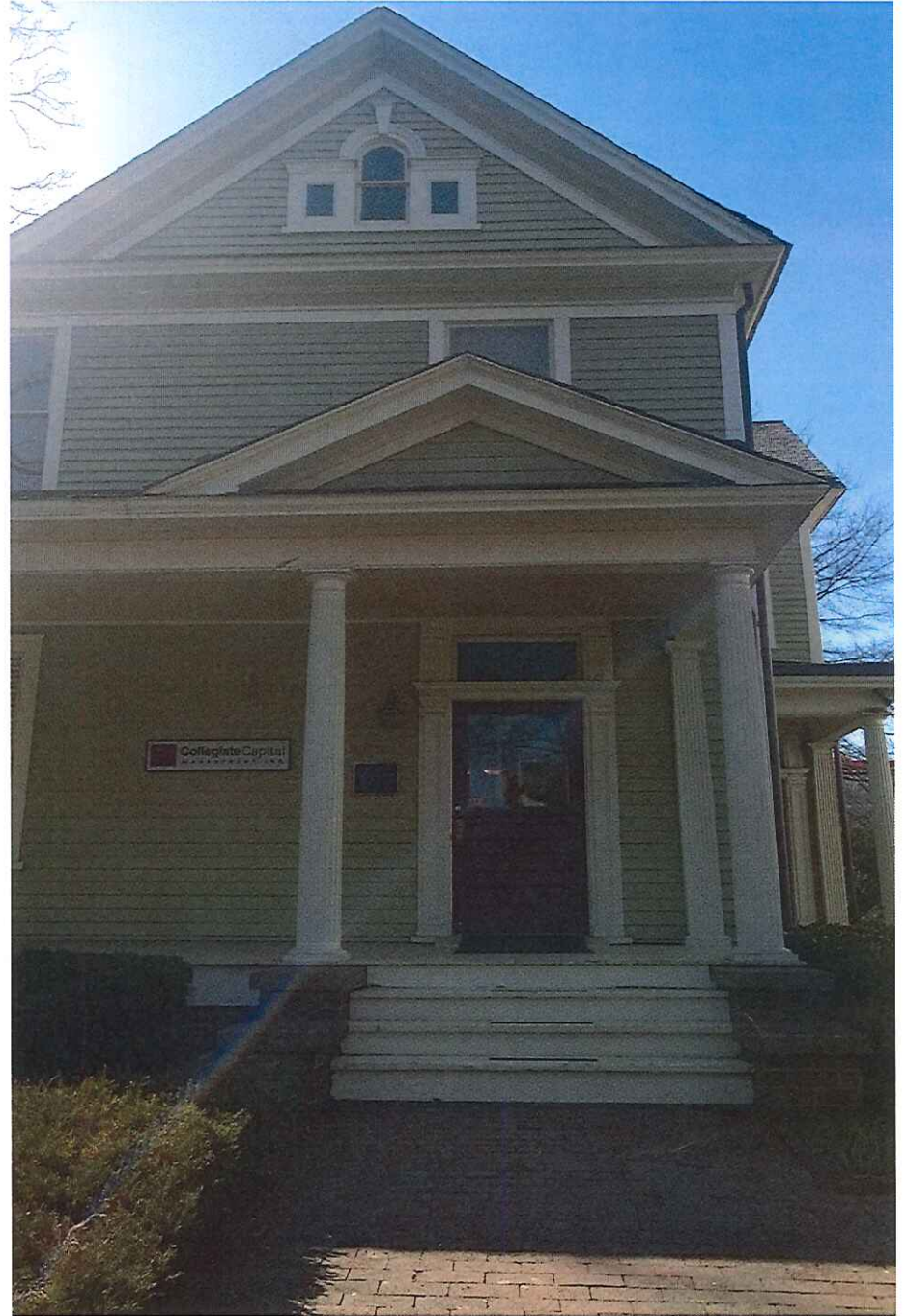
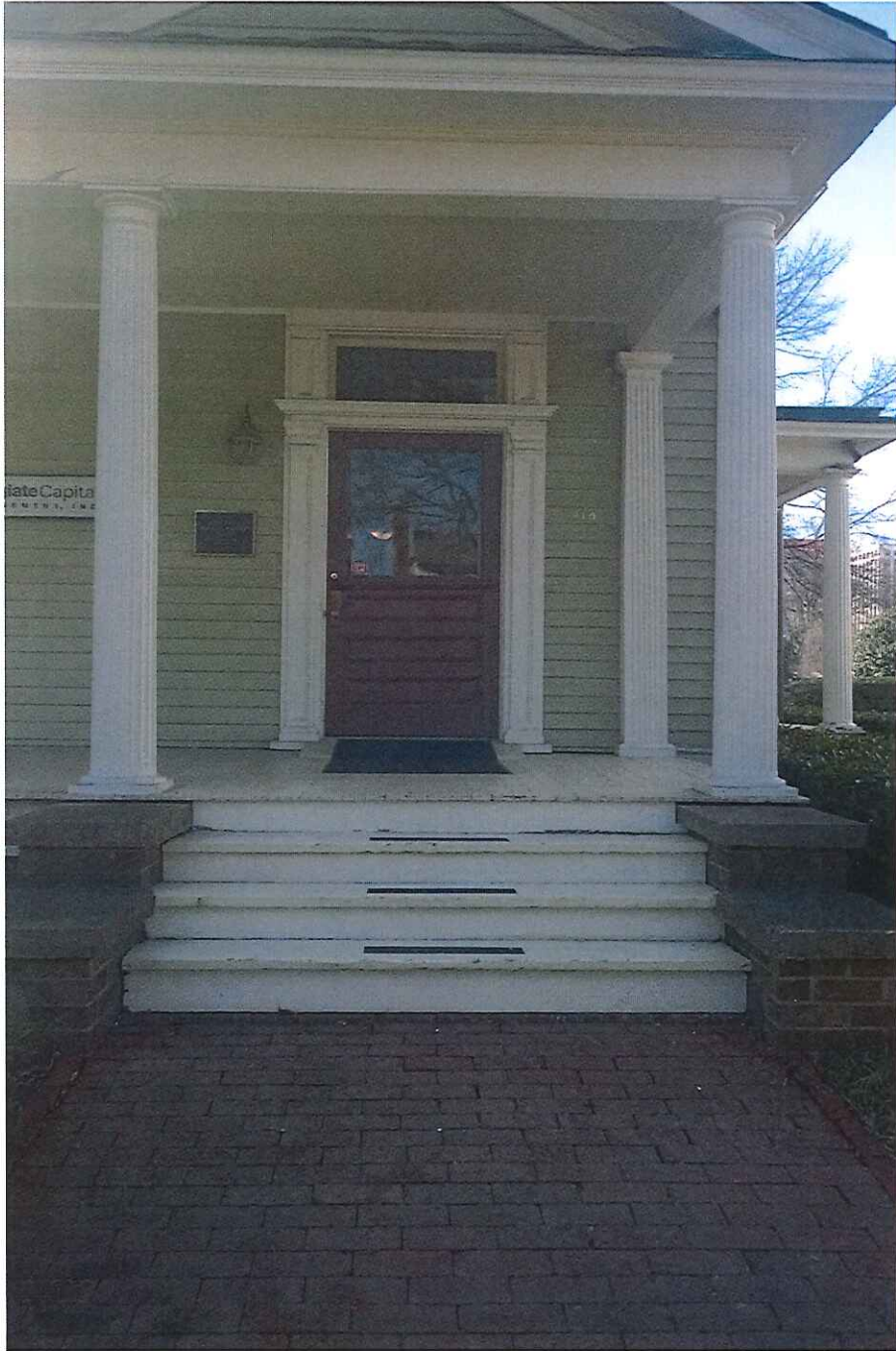

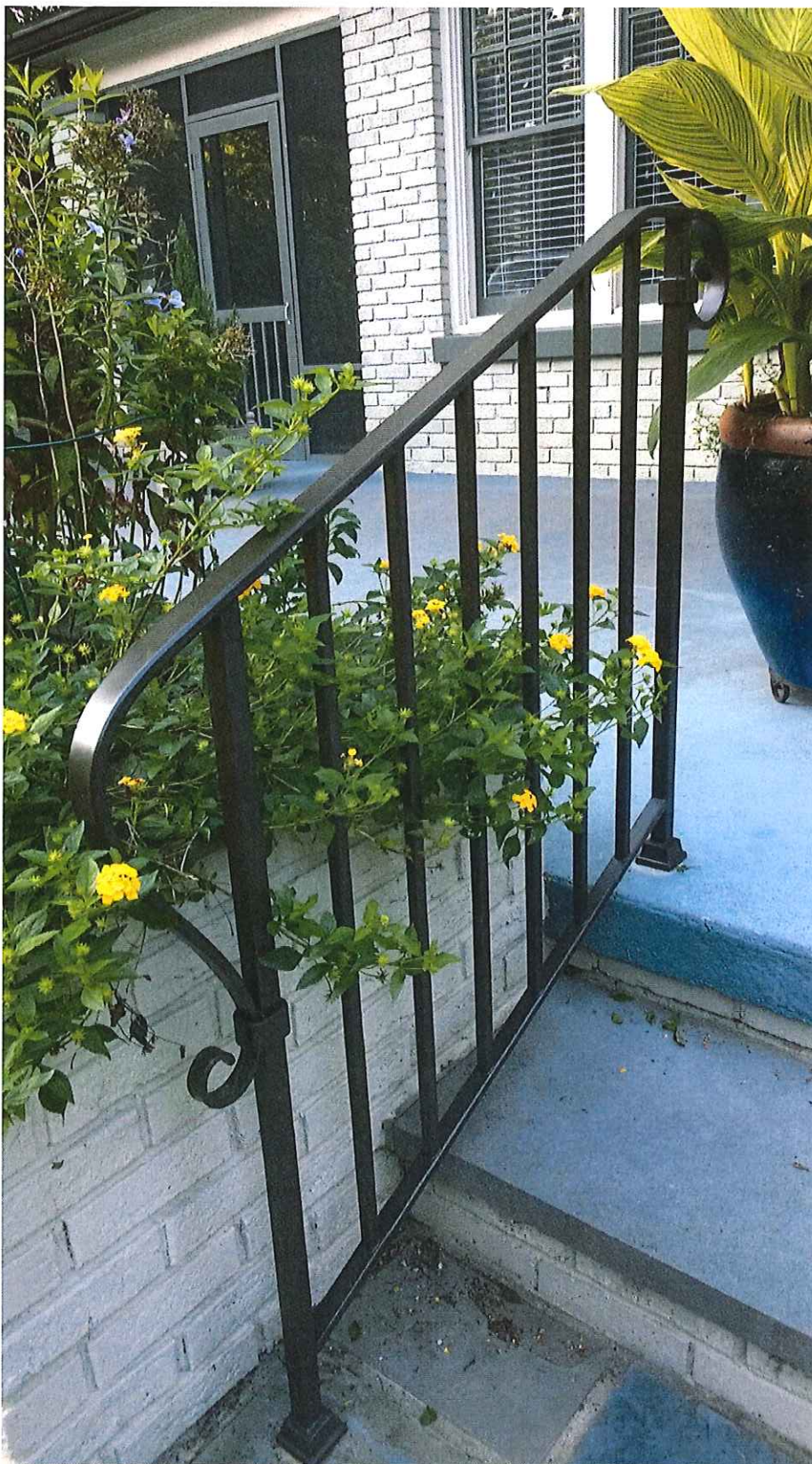




Pictures of identical railings installed recently at a residential property in Raleigh.

Same color will be used at 214 New Bern Place. A sample of the paint color is enclosed.

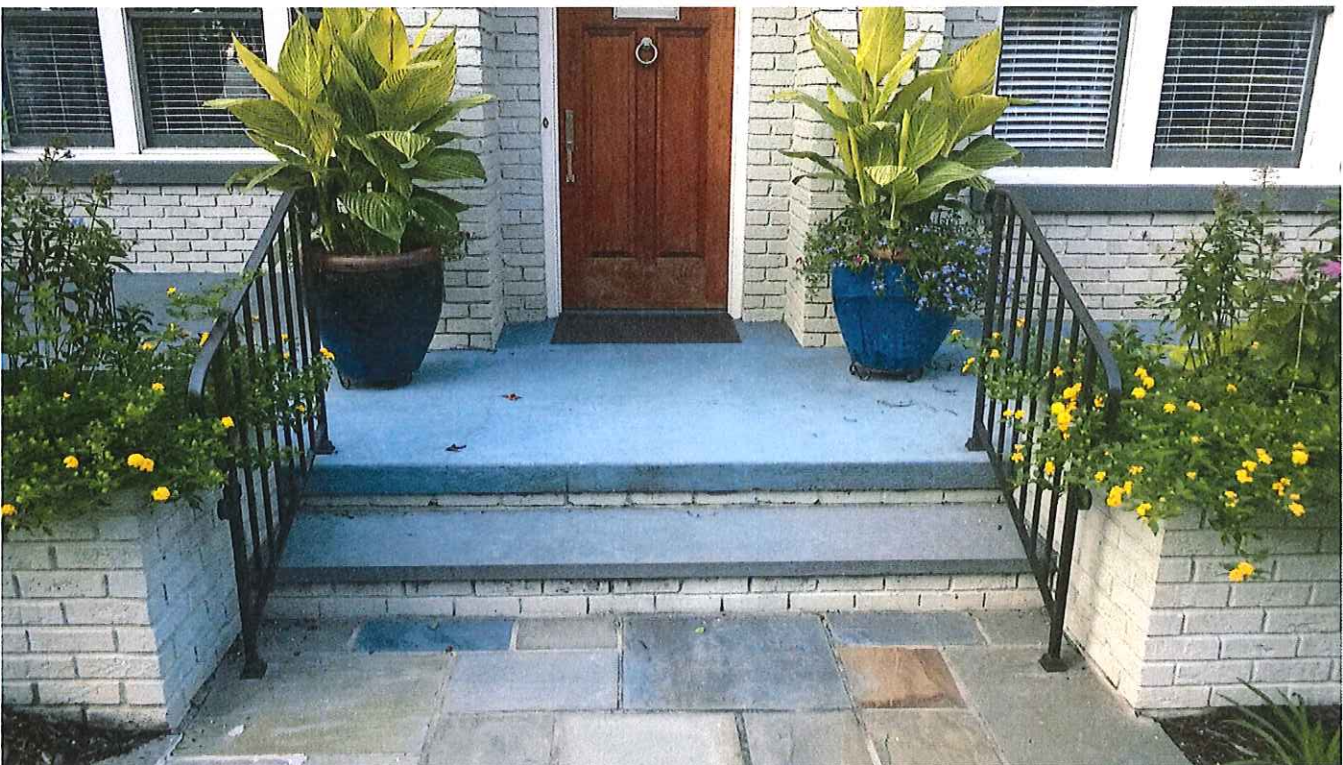

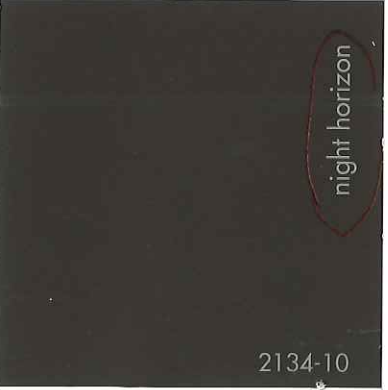
