RE: Corridor Public Meeting for the Mitchell Mill Road Widening Project

Dear Property Owner:

The City of Raleigh is proposing to improve Mitchell Mill Road. The proposed improvements consist of widening the roadway section from Louisburg Road to Forestville Road. At the pre-design public meeting in April, we presented the project limits from Louisburg Road to Watkins Road. After further review we are proposing to revise the project's eastern limits. Our engineering design consultant, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. has completed initial studies and preliminary design mapping is now available for the purpose of showing you the proposed improvements. To accomplish this, we have scheduled a public meeting for Thursday, September 23, 2010 at Wake Cross Roads Baptist Church, 3329 Forestville Road (a location map is provided on the reverse).


We will be available from 7:00 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. to review/discuss the mapping and answer any questions you may have. Beginning at 7:30 P.M., the public meeting will convene and a short presentation will be made that will explain the results of the corridor studies as well as discuss the preliminary project design. At the conclusion of the presentation, you will be given the opportunity to ask questions or make comments concerning the design.
