

Background

In October 2007, City of Raleigh residents approved a Parks and Recreation Bond that included funding for the Neuse River Greenway Trail acquisition, design, and construction.

The Neuse River Greenway Trail is planned to extend from the Falls Lake Dam in North Central Wake County to the Wake/Johnston County line in Southeast Wake County. The first section of the trail from Falls Lake Dam to the CASL Soccer Complex, a length of approximately 8 miles, will begin construction in Spring 2009 and should open in Summer 2010. When complete, the entire trail will stretch for 28 miles including connections along both Walnut Creek and Crabtree Creek. It is anticipated that future connections will be made to the neighboring localities of Wake Forest and Knightdale.

It is exciting to note that the Mountain to Sea Trail, a state-wide recreation trail extending from Murfreesboro to Manteo is planned to follow the Neuse River Greenway Trail through this portion of Wake County.

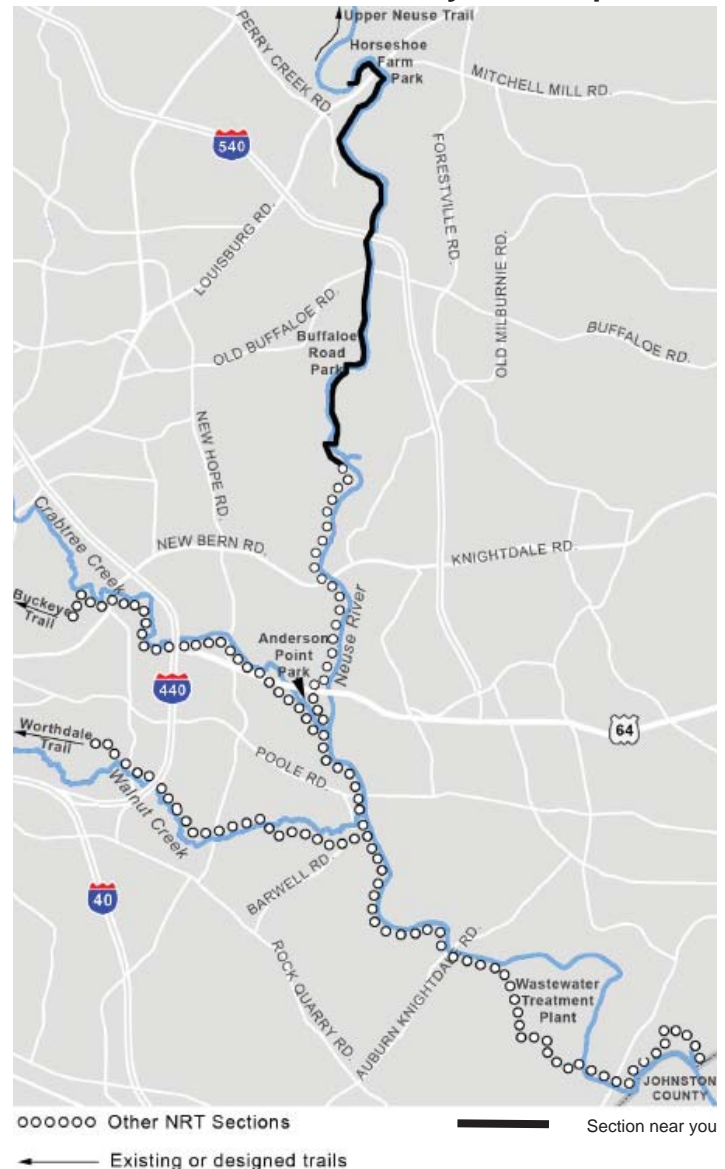
