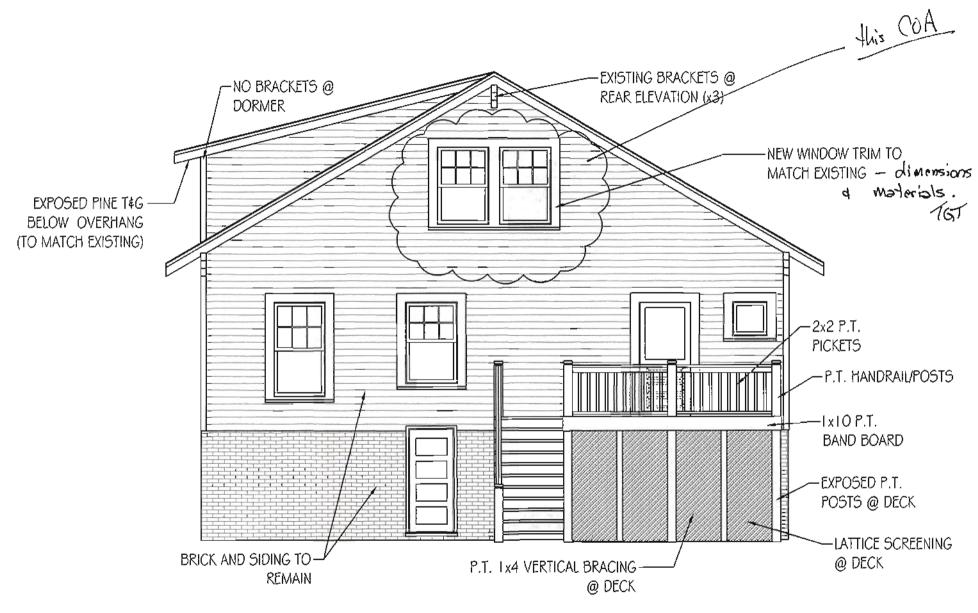
This is the COA Application for our replacement windows at 525 Euclid (noted on elevation drawings).

The windows at the rear elevation will be the same as the approved windows on the right/dormer (See elevation. The window on the left elevation will be a 3/10 x 3/6 fixed clear window. They will be the same window brand and designation that were approved previously (Lincoln SDL).

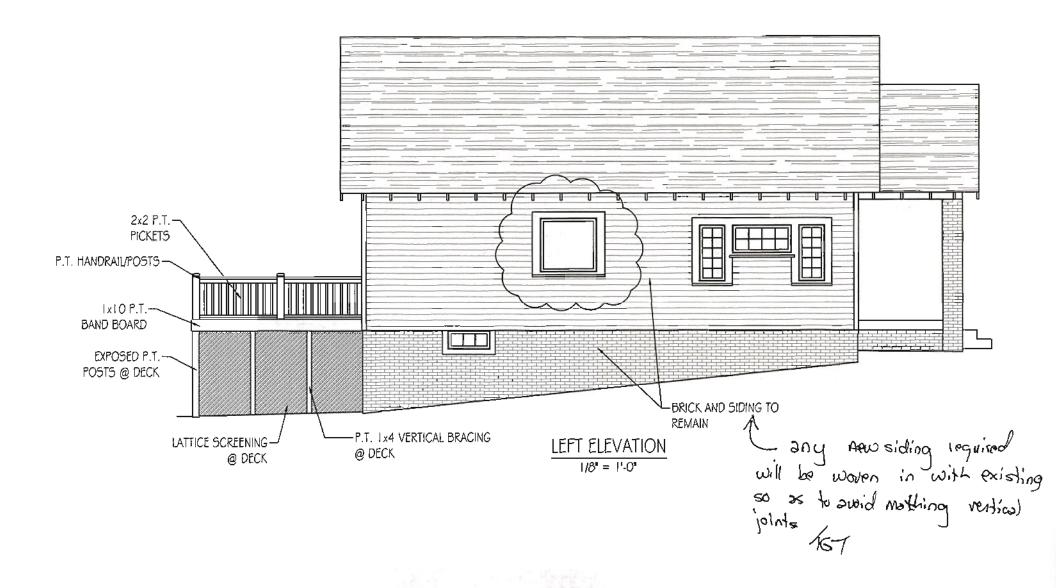
Upon removing the old shingles for the new dormer, we will be replacing the shingles with <u>Owens-Corning "Oakridge"</u> Lifetime Architectural shingles, color Driftwood. The area of roof over the dormer will require a waterproof roof system that will be black in color, no shingles.
