



To Whom it May Concern:

Located in back yard. DBH 18-22 inches. The Maple tree should be removed due to the rot at the base of the tree. It poses a hazard to person and property.

The Hack berry tree in the back yard, has large limbs over structures on the Mrs. Miller property. The hack berry has very weak limbs, and with the included bark ridge apparent in the these limbs, I recommend removal of the limbs to protect the underlying structure from damage.

All work will be done according to ANSI standards of pruning and tree removal.
