




We will be installing 6 heat pump systems outside as the site map shows. (Site map attached) They will be screened by 4' evergreen shrubs (Picture attached)


We will be installing 3 new brick vents into the basement exterior wall (approximately 9"x11"). The color of the brick vent will be brown a similar image is attached.




















Ductless Split outdoor heat pump unit
